

What is a 501(c)(3) Determination Letter?

The **IRS Determination Letter** notifies a nonprofit organization that its application for federal tax exemption under Section 501(c)(3) has been approved. In summary, it confirms that your organization is exempt from federal income tax. Also, it confirms that your donors can claim their contributions to your organization on their annual tax returns.

Organizations seeking to apply for a Prairie Meadows grant must be in possession of this document. Not sure what the letter looks like? See the example below:
