Public Comment. None

<u>Financials.</u> Ms. Castelline noted there has been no significant revenue since PM shut down March 16; we're current with our obligations; we opened June 15 and will have more details in July. Mr. Rhines said we'll have a litany of statistics at the next Board Meeting; we've been open for nine days.

<u>Update – Opening Day.</u> Mr. Palmer said we were all excited to open; we have limitations on social distancing and gaming positions; no one has been turned away due to a temperature of 100.4 either in the Casino or the Backside; we want to keep everyone healthy and have fun; we're excited about the future; we're looking forward to July 3 and the fireworks – only a few places are doing fireworks this year and we want to celebrate our independence and our future.

<u>Update – Recalled Employees.</u> Mr. Rhines said we reopened in a phased approach with recalls tied to revenue; we've been open nine days and just under 49% of the employees have been recalled; total employee recall to date is 678 and 1,393 was the budgeted number; we're entering the next phase of recall with Table Games employees and its support areas; Table Games will open on July 1 and will be at 50% business capacity; when restrictions are lifted, more employees will be recalled.

Racing Update. Mr. Heldt reported:

- We had a lot of meetings with the IQHRA and HBPA regarding the Racing calendar; we'll have a Mixed Meet of 67 days running June 19 October 10; four days of Racing a week Friday and Saturday at 6:00 p.m. and Sunday and Monday at 4:00 p.m.; the groups then met to work on next year's purses and calendar to ensure we have a great program this year and next year the framework is in place; we'll start meeting August 1 to work on next year's program.
- The Backside opened June 1 and horses started arriving June 2; the training and main tracks are open for gallops and workouts to qualify for some of the special races.
- In March, we had 2,300 stall applications; to date, we have 802 Thoroughbred and 276 Quarter Horse stalls filled; there are some empty stalls and some trainers are still traveling; in a week or so, we'll start filling the empty stalls.
- Opening weekend started June 19; we had good crowds Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. Offtrack handle was up 100% and on-track handle was down \$37,000 due to the mix of days compared to last year (2019 - Thursday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday; 2020 – Friday, Saturday, Sunday, Monday).
- Friday, June 26 the Quarter Horses will start racing, and the next 55 days will be a Mixed Meet with Thoroughbreds and Quarter Horses, ending September 27; the last seven days are only Thoroughbred Races, ending October 10.
- We're off to a good start and look to continue a great Racing season.
