Rising Artist Dylan Scott Coming to Altoona

Prairie Meadows to Hold Outdoor Concert on Track Apron in July

May 2 – Altoona, IA. Nothing says summer like an outdoor concert, and Prairie Meadows has a memorable one planned. SmithField's current single, *Hey Whiskey* is resonating with the music industry and fans alike.

The concert will be general admission and all ages are welcome. Guests are encouraged to bring lawn chairs or blankets to sit on while enjoying the show.
