HISA REGISTRATION:

<u>Covered Persons</u> – Anyone who holds a Racing License and has access to the barn area MUST be registered with the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority (HISA). Go to www.hisaus.org to register.

<u>Covered Horses</u> – Any Thoroughbred horse, beginning on the day of the horse's first official timed workout at a racetrack or training facility (or when entered or nominated to a race) and ending when the horse has been officially retired, is a Covered Horse. Covered Horses must be registered with HISA on or before the date of the first official timed workout (or entry or nomination to a race). HORSES THAT ARE NOT REGISTERED WITH HISA WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO RACE.

ATTENTION PLEASE!!!: At the time of publication for this book, there remains pending litigation involving constitutionality, rules, requirements, enforcement, etc. of HISA. Modifications of rules or requirements associated with / enforced by HISA are SUBJECT TO CHANGE based on pending litigation or approval process.

AGENT ENTRIES

Individuals that hold a jockey agent license, regardless of other licenses held, shall not be permitted to make Thoroughbred entries after 9:30am.

ELIGIBILITY RULES

- Horses that have started for a claiming price of less than \$2,500 will not be eligible to stable or race at Prairie Meadows unless they have won for \$2,500 or more since starting for less than \$2,500.
- Thoroughbred maidens that have started for a claiming price of less than \$5,000 will not be eligible to stable or race at Prairie Meadows. Quarter Horse maidens that have started for a claiming price of less than \$2,500 will not be eligible to stable or race at Prairie Meadows.
- Thoroughbred maidens older than six (6) years old will not be eligible to stable or race at Prairie Meadows. Quarter Horse maidens older than five (5) years old must have competed in a pari-mutuel race within twelve (12) months of the race to be eligible to race at Prairie Meadows.
- 4. Horses over twelve (12) years of age will not be eligible to stable or race at Prairie Meadows.
- 5. All horses and ponies must have a current negative coggins test within twelve (12) months when entering the stable area.
- No ponies allowed without approval of Prairie Meadows. A Stall Application must be on file in the Racing Office. (Stables must be allotted 10 or more stalls to have a pony approved).
- Horses which meet eligibility requirements cannot make themselves ineligible while racing at the current meet.
- 8. Eligibility does not imply automatic stall approval.

CONDITION ELIGIBILITY FOR QUARTER HORSE RACES

Means horses that meet the condition of the race are preferred over those that do not. Example: winners of two races entering into non-winners of three races would have preference over a horse that has only one win regardless of preference date.

PREFERENCE

- In over-filled races, preference will be given to horses in order of their assigned preference date, earliest date first. Horses having identical preference dates will be chosen by lot.
- 2. Preference dates will not supersede conditions of the race.
- 3. All horses intending to race at Prairie Meadows will be assigned a preference date. A horse can only have one date at any particular time. Horses will not be eligible to receive a date until their foal papers and coggins are on file in the Racing Office. Dates assigned will be of two types:
 - All Thoroughbreds registering by Thursday May 1, 2025 at 12:00 PM (Noon) or Quarter Horses by Friday, June 6, 2025 will receive a zero (0 date), which is the lowest date possible.
 - b) All Thoroughbreds registering after Thursday May 1, 2025 at 12:00 PM (Noon) or Quarter Horses after Friday, June 6, 2025 will receive a R1 (one) or an R (R date) corresponding to the day of the meeting when registered.
- Note: Horses without a current negative coggins with foal papers will not be able to receive a
 preference date.
- 5. Preference dates are good at any distance.
- 6. A zero (0) date has first preference.
- Horses that enter and are in the body of a race will receive an R date corresponding to the day of the meet they race and lose any date previously held. This excludes stakes, handicap stakes and trials.
- 8. Horses which scratch or are scratched will be assigned an R date as if they had run.
- A horse placed on the steward's, starter's, or vet's list will lose their date and be assigned an R
 date corresponding to the day of the meet they are removed from the list.
- 10. Horses which have established a date will lose said date should their papers be withdrawn from the Racing Office, or demonstrate intent to race elsewhere. Should papers be removed from the Racing Office for just cause (i.e. Tattoo, etc.), the Racing Secretary may determine the status of the preference date established.
- 11. A horse which is a scheduled starter in a canceled race will retain their previous date.
- 12. In no way does the transfer of ownership or trainer transfer affect a horse's preference date.
- 13. When a horse name appears in the body of a race, other than a stakes or trial race, and is entered on a following day, such entry will receive no consideration should the race in which it is entered be over-filled.
- 14. In rule numbers 3 (b) and 7 above, should a horse be registered, or come off a list on a non-racing day, the next racing day will be used as its preference date.

STAKES PREFERENCE

- 1. Unless the specific conditions of an open stakes states otherwise the following will apply:
- In the event more than twelve (12) horses enter, high weights on the scale, taking into consideration sex and age, shall be preferred.
- 3. Different owner entries shall receive equal draw according to weights.

PREFERENCE FOR IOWA-BRED STAKES

Preference to start will be given to those horses having accumulated the highest 2024-2025 earnings at the closing time of entries. This preference will be utilized regardless of the ownership of the horses involved.

WINNERS PREFERRED

Unless specific conditions of a race state otherwise, in all races winners shall receive first preference.

HEALTH CERTIFICATE / EHV-1 / PIROPLASMOSIS / COGGINS

THOROUGHBREDS AND ALL PONIES

All thoroughbreds and ALL ponies, shipping to Prairie Meadows must be accompanied by a valid health certificate issued within 5 days prior to arrival at the track, which shows the vaccination record and administration date for each horse. The horse must have been vaccinated with an FDA approved modified live or killed virus vaccine for the following Eastern and Western Encephalitis, West Nile Virus, Tetanus and Rabies vaccine given within the prior 12 months; Influenza and Rhinopneumonitis Vaccine given within the prior 180 days or sooner if high risk situations dictate. A current actual copy of a negative coggins test dated within twelve (12) months must accompany the health certificate. A negative coggins result listed on the health certificate is NOT ACCEPTABLE. You must provide an actual copy of the Coggins test form.

Any quarter horse pony horse must have proof of a negative test for <u>Theileria Equi (Piroplasmosis)</u>. The test must have been performed within the past 365 days and include the tattoo number of the horse or an accurate description. A copy of the original test is acceptable. This requirement is for all Quarter Horses entering Prairie Meadows racetrack and includes any pony horse, other than a Thoroughbred pony. It is suggested that a copy of the test be attached to the foal papers in a manner similar to coggins tests.

A current, negative coggins test is required of all horses, including ponies arriving at Prairie Meadows. The test certificate or copy thereof must be on file in the Racing Office. All coggins and piroplasmosis tests must be dated within twelve (12) months.

Said documents must be presented at the stable gate upon arrival or horses will not be permitted to enter the stable area. Any questions regarding these requirements should be directed to either your practicing veterinarian or the Iowa Racing & Gaming Commission State Vet's Office.

QUARTER HORSES

All Quarter Horse racehorses, shipping to Prairie Meadows must be accompanied by a valid health certificate issued within 10 days prior to arrival at the track, which shows the vaccination record for each horse. The horse must have been vaccinated with an FDA approved modified live or killed virus vaccine for EHV-1 not less than 14 days and not more than 180 days prior to date of entry and the veterinarian must provide the date of vaccination. A current actual copy of a negative coggins test dated within twelve (12) months must accompany the health certificate. A negative coggins result listed on the health certificate is NOT ACCEPTABLE. You must provide an actual copy of the Coggins test form.

All Quarter Horses and any pony horse, other than a Thoroughbred pony, must have proof of a negative test for <u>Theileria Equi (Piroplasmosis)</u>. The test must have been performed within the past 365 days and include the tattoo number of the horse or an accurate description. A copy of the original test is acceptable. This requirement is for all Quarter Horses entering Prairie Meadows racetrack and includes any pony horse, other than a Thoroughbred pony. It is suggested that a copy of the test be attached to the foal papers in a manner similar to coggins tests. A current, negative coggins test is required of all horses, including ponies arriving at Prairie

Meadows. The test certificate or copy thereof must be on file in the Racing Office. All coggins and piroplasmosis tests must be dated within twelve (12) months.

Said documents must be presented at the stable gate upon arrival or horses will not be permitted to enter the stable area. Any questions regarding these requirements should be directed to either your practicing veterinarian or the Iowa Racing & Gaming Commission State Vet's Office. Vaccination against other disorders (Eastern and Western Encephalitis, West Nile Virus, Influenza, Tetanus and Rabies) is highly recommended and may be required if an outbreak occurs.

SHIP IN TO RACE

- Under no circumstances should any horse be shipped to Prairie Meadows without first securing arrangements with the Stall Superintendent at 1-800-325-9015 Ext. 1209.
- Horses shipping in to race will be assigned a stall in the Receiving Bam (A3) by the Stall Superintendent. Trainers wanting to ship into another Trainer's bam must first receive permission from the Stall Superintendent prior to shipping and arrival at the Stable Gate. If a ship-in horse will not be in the Receiving Barn, the trainer must also notify the State Veterinarian at 515-240-8731 (Dr. Sweeney) or 641-344-7230 (Dr. Bradley) prior to pre-race exams that are conducted from 8:00 – 10:45 AM on race days.
- 3. Horses shipping in to race <u>MUST</u> be on the grounds in their assigned stall no later than <u>10:45 a.m. or at least 4 ½ hours before the post time for the first race, whichever is earlier</u>. If for an unforeseen reason, the horse will not be on the grounds prior to 10:45am or at least 4 ½ hours prior to post time for the first race, the trainer must contact the Stewards at 515-967-1201 to ask for permission to arrive late <u>AND</u> must contact the State Veterinarian at 515-240-8731 (Dr. Sweeney) or 641-344-7230 (Dr. Bradley) to make arrangements for a pre-race exam.
- 4. Horses must vacate the receiving barn by 7:00 a.m. the day after they race.

STABLING OF QUARTER HORSE FINALISTS

If a horse is a finalist for a stake race that had nomination, sustaining and/or late supplemental payments in order to be eligible to participate and qualified through time trials, the horse shall remain on facility premises until the running of the final. If a horse becomes a finalist for a stake race that does not run qualifying time trials due to not having enough entrants to run trials, that horse must be stabled on facility premises by the date time trials were scheduled and remain on facility premises until the running of the final. A horse removed from facility premises or is not stabled on facility premises by the date time trials were scheduled, will not be allowed to enter for the final or will be scratched from the final and will not be eligible for a refund of the fees paid or earn any purse monies from the final.

OTHER LIVESTOCK ON PROPERTY

- Live poultry (roosters, chickens, ducks, etc.) are strictly prohibited on Prairie Meadows property.
- Trainer stables are allowed to have goats and sheep on the condition that they serve as
 companionship for a specific equine in their stable and are appropriately tagged for Scrapie
 identification or tattooed. Any goat or sheep found without a Scrapie ID shall be removed
 from the grounds immediately. Goats and sheep must remain in the interior of the barn at all
 times. Any goat or sheep found roaming beyond its trainers' assigned stall area will be
 required to be removed from the property immediately.

HORSE ID / LIP - DIGITAL TATTOO / CERTIFICATES / MICROCHIP

Sign up for tattooing at Prairie Meadows race office, and <u>list the horse's name, barn number, your</u> <u>name and cell phone number</u>. A Digital Tattoo™ is required for any horse that is planning to make their first lifetime start at Prairie Meadows. Thoroughbred identification has transitioned from lip tattooing to utilizing the Digital Tattoo (Picture Horse ID) which is accessible through the scanning of the Jockey Club-issued microchip that has been implanted into the horse's neck by the breeder. The process will be as follows:

- All foals of 2017 and forward must be micro-chipped before the Jockey Club will
 register the horse.
- TRPB identifiers will come to your barn, scan the microchip to pull up the digital copy
 of the foal papers, and verify the markings prior to your being allowed to race.
 Additionally, the TRPB identifiers will take a series of photographs of your horse.

Effective January 1, 2024, the Digital Tattoo™ fee is \$110 (subject to change) which <u>MUST</u> be in your account at Prairie Meadows prior to the TRPB® Technician performing the work. Payment can also be made by Credit Card, Apple Pay or Google Pay.

Digital certificates were introduced in 2018 to streamline management of the official certificate of registration throughout the life of a Thoroughbred. Foals of 2018 and after will be issued Digital Certificates. When a horse is registered with the Jockey Club, the person performing the registration is prompted to designate the first certificate manager. The certificate manager has control of the digital certificate, similar to having possession of a paper certificate. A certificate manager can assign a certificate to an individual / entity, sales company, racetrack, or The Jockey Club Registry. During the assignment process, current ownership information can be updated, and if certificate management is assigned to a racetrack, a trainer must be selected. Digital certificates also show logos that indicate Breeders' Cup nomination, TRPB digital tattoo status, many state breeders' programs, and other important designations. Documents such as coggins, a bill of sale, and lowa registered stamp confirmation can be uploaded to a digital certificate and are indicated by a paperclip icon.

Quarter Horses that need to be tattooed will need to sign up with Horse ID in the Racing Office. Effective January 1, 2024, microchips instead of lip tattoos will be a component of identifying racing Quarter Horses. Any horse that has not previously been tattooed as of January 1, 2024, will require a microchip. The number will be scanned and used as part of the identification verification done by the AQHA contracted identifier. The fee for identification will remain \$120 (subject to change) of which \$30 will be reimbursed to the identifier. Credit card payments are the only form of payment accepted at the time of identification.

REPORTING OF GELDINGS / GENDER

It is the Trainer's responsibility to record the sex of the horses in the trainer's care and immediately report any alteration of the sex of a horse to the Horse Identifier or Racing Office

FUROSEMIDE (LASIX)

All HISA COVERED horses (Thoroughbreds) will follow HISA and HiWU regulations for medications and administration times. Quarter Horses follow guidelines listed below.

- The form prescribed by the commission for the use of furosemide shall be considered the official entry form and the declaration for use must be made at entry time, noting either furosemide use or first-time furosemide use.
- The eligibility of horses for use of furosemide must be determined before entry and is the responsibility of the trainer Please check with the commission veterinarian if you have questions regarding furosemide use.
- Any horse that bleeds through furosemide for the first time within 365 days, will not be allowed to race for a period of 14 calendar days, beginning the day after the incident.
- The form for discontinuance of furosemide must be filled out in the commission veterinarian office at or before entry time.

3RD PARTY (LASIX) ADMINISTRATION ~~*IN-TODAY SIGNS~~*

- <u>A third-party independent veterinarian</u> (***SUBJECT TO CHANGE***) shall administer Lasix. A rule change requires an "in-today" sign be placed outside of the horse's stall that is running regardless of if a horse is to receive Lasix or not to receive Lasix.
- Once your horse is placed on the overnight to run, please come to either the H.B.P.A. Office or the Racing Office to pick up an "in-today" sign. The sign will have a place for you to indicate which race the horse is in AND the dosage amount you wish for your horse to receive.
- The sign MUST be in front of the horse's stall that is running by 8:00 a.m. the day of that horse's race. Prairie Meadows has positioned holders located on the front of every stall, for you to put the sign in.
- 4. You must have a person present for the administration of Lasix. Also, this is a reminder that no veterinarian, other than the third-party administration veterinarian, is to be in the horse's stall starting at 6:00 P.M. the day before the race, except in the case of emergency. However, prior to entering the stall a State Veterinarian must be notified.

OUT OF COMPETITION TESTING

Out-of-competition testing (OOCT) will be conducted during the 2025 Prairie Meadows racing meets. Horses that test positive for a prohibited substance or trainers that refuse to submit a horse for OOCT will result in the refusal to accept an entry of that horse to race at Prairie Meadows and may result in the refusal to take entries of any horse under the trainer's care or may result in the revocation of stalls for the meet. Please contact the state veterinarians with questions pertaining to the procedures for OOCT. Please note: Up to \$5.00 per starter <u>may be</u> deducted by the Horsemen's Bookkeeper to help cover the cost of OOCT.

TEST BARN

First and Second placed horses in overnight races and First, Second, and Third placed horses in stakes races, as well as any other horses requested by the state vets or the stewards must report to the test barn immediately following the race. All entered horses may be subject to pre-race blood gas testing. Failure to comply will result in the horse being scratched.

TRANSFERS

All owner or trainer transfers regarding horses of record (registration certificate on file in the racing office physically or digitally or have started at the race meet) must be approved by the stewards.

NAMING OF RIDERS

- 1. Riders must be named at the time of entry.
- Before naming any rider, the trainer, owner, or other person authorized must first engage the services of the rider and state on the entry or to the person taking the entry whether it is a first or second call, excluding trial races.
- Any owner, trainer, or other duly authorized person failing to follow this procedure will be subject to disciplinary action.

WEIGHTS

- Owners, trainers and other duly authorized persons must be careful to claim allowances at the time of entry and are solely responsible if a horse starts with the incorrect weight and is therefore disqualified.
- After a horse is entered and has been assigned a weight to carry in a race the assignment of weight shall not be changed except to correct an error and by permission of the Stewards.
- Horses not entitled to the first allowance in a race are not entitled to the second, and if not the second, then to no subsequent allowance.
- 4. The clauses "maiden, claiming, or starter not considered" and/or "races where entered for _____ or less not considered" shall apply both to the eligibility and to the allowance unless otherwise specified by the conditions of the race.

IOWA-FOALED HORSE WEIGHT ALLOWANCE

Per I.R.G.C. Rule 10.4(5)(g)(5), lowa-foaled horses that are properly registered and whose papers are stamped by the lowa Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship shall be allowed an additional three (3) pounds beyond the stated conditions of the race, if the race is not limited to lowa-foaled horses. This allowance does not apply to Stakes races.

CHANGE OF EQUIPMENT

- All trainers requesting a change of blinkers or cheek pieces must first secure a card from the starter certifying that the horse has broken from the gate with blinkers or cheek pieces.
- All trainers who request a flipping halter must secure permission from the starter before time of entry. The use of a flipping halter or Cornell collar must be declared at time of entry.
- Horses must run in the same equipment as their last start, unless you have a change of equipment card.
- 4. Change of equipment must be declared at the time of entry.

PADDOCK

All horses must be saddled within the Saddling Paddock enclosure. No horses will be allowed to be saddled outside of the Saddling Paddock enclosure for any reason. Pony horses are not allowed in the Saddling Paddock enclosure. Lip chains must be covered with no bare metal. Any person leading a horse to the paddock will be required to wear a numbered vest for identification of the horse to the public. All paddock attendees must be neatly dressed.

PROPER ATTIRE TO PONY A HORSE TO THE POST

Proper dress, safety helmets and vest will be required when ponying a horse to the post. All pony escorts must wear attire designated by Prairie Meadows and can be acquired or purchased from the Racing Office.

SHOES

<u>Thoroughbreds</u>: HISA Rule 2276 Except for full rims 2mm (two millimeters) or less from the ground surface of the shoe, traction devices are prohibited on forelimb and hindlimb* (Note: July 29, 2022 Update Below) shoes during racing and training. Traction devices include but are not limited to rims, toe grabs, bends, jar calks and stickers. Note: Rule 2276 shall not be enforced for horses racing on dirt surfaces that are shod on the hindlimbs with traction devices in the form of *either a full outer rim shoe (up to 4mm in height) or a toe grab (up to 4mm in height) *. All other provisions of Rule 2276 shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>Quarter Horses</u>: Front shoes shall not have a toe grab or anything else more than 4mm (four millimeters) from the ground surface side of the shoe. Hind horse shoes shall not have a toe grab or anything else more than one-quarter (1/4) inch from the ground surface side of the shoe.

WORKOUTS

Thoroughbreds:

- a. A horse that has not started for a period of 60 days or more shall have an official workout satisfactory to the Stewards prior to the day of the race in which the horse started and the horse must have an official workout within the previous 30 days.
- b. A horse that has not started for a period of 180 days or more must have two official workouts, one of which must have occurred within the previous 30 days prior to the day of the race in which the horse starts.
- c. A horse that has not started for a period of 365 days or more must fulfill the following requirements before being allowed to start:
 - a. Must have three official workouts
 - b. One of the three official workouts must be from the Starting Gate going at least one-half mile within 60 days of starting.
- d. No first-time starters shall be allowed to race unless it has three official workouts, with one having occurred from the Starting Gate within the previous 60 days and be approved from the Starting Gate by the Starter.

Quarter Horses:

- A horse that has not started for a period of 60 days or more shall be ineligible to race until it has completed an official workout satisfactory to the Stewards prior to the day of the race in which the horse started and the horse must have an official workout within the previous 60 days.
- A horse that has not started for a period of 180 days or more must have two official workouts, one of which must have occurred within the previous 60 days.
- 3. A horse that has not started for a period of 365 days or more must fulfill the following requirements before being allowed to start:
 - a. Must have two official workouts.
 - One of the two official workouts must be from the Starting Gate within 60 days of starting.
- 4. No first-time starters shall be allowed to race until it has two official workouts, with one having occurred from the Starting Gate within the previous 60 days and be approved from the Starting Gate by the Starter.

For the purpose of counting the number of days a horse is ineligible to start, the day after the workout shall be considered the first day.

SCRATCHES

- The scratching of a horse out of an engagement for a race is irrevocable. All scratches must be approved by the Stewards.
- If there is an also-eligible in a race on the overnight, that horse may be entered on subsequent entry days with a scratch card. If the horse draws into the body of the race the subsequent race day, the Stewards receive the scratch card for the race in which the horse was an also eligible, and the horse is scratched.
- Scratch time will be established prior to the start of the meet and posted in the Racing Office and on the Overnight sheets.

COUPLING ENTRIES / CONSECUTIVE DAYS

There will be no coupled entries in any race. In races, excluding stakes races, that overfill, trainers must declare preference of runners with identical ownership at time of entry. Same-owner, second-choice horses will be least preferred. A trainer or owner may not enter more than three (3) horses in a race unless the race is split or divided.

No horse shall run twice within four (4) calendar days. For the purpose of this rule, the day after the start shall count as the first day.

OWNER'S SILKS

- 1. Racing silks shall be turned in to the Racing Office or Jockey Room Custodian upon arrival to the facility.
 - a. All horses running in a race are required to race in either Owner or Trainer Silks.
 - b. In the case of a partnership, the horse shall run with a managing partner silks or Trainer silks if no partnership silks are available.
 - Under special circumstances, the Stewards may permit a horse to run in "house" silks.
- 2. Prairie Meadows will not be held responsible for any silks left here after the end of the meet.

THOROUGHBRED WAIVER-CLAIMING RULES

<u>Per HISA Rule 2263 which will be effective July 8, 2024</u>, a new provision is added which allows a Responsible Person to declare a Covered Horse to be ineligible to be claimed for a second consecutive race provided certain conditions are met, including:

- a. The waiver was asserted in the first race back;
- b. The horse does not win its first race back;
- c. No change in majority ownership; and
- d. The horse is entered in a claiming race with a claiming price equal to or greater than the claiming price for which it last started.

Permitting a second consecutive waiver encourages owner / trainer continuity and is in the best interest of the Covered Horse.

The requirements to declare a horse ineligible to be claimed (Waiver) the first time:

- A horse is not an official starter at any racetrack for a minimum of 120 days since its last race as an official starter.
- The last race was one in which the horse was eligible to be claimed.
- The horse is entered for a claiming price equal to or greater than the claiming price at which it last started as an official starter.
- Failure of declaration of ineligibility (Waiver) at time of entry may not be remedied.

CLAIMING

- 1. Registered to race or open claim. No person may file a claim for any horse unless the person:
 - a. Is a licensed owner at the meeting who either has foal paper(s) registered with the racing secretary's office or has started a horse at the meeting; or
 - b. Is a licensed authorized agent, authorized to claim for an owner eligible to claim; or
 - c. Has a valid open claim certificate. Any person not licensed as an owner or a licensed authorized agent for the account of the same or a licensed owner not having foal paper(s) registered with the Racing Secretary's office or who has not started a horse at the current meeting may request an open claim certificate from the commission.
 - d. Is not a family member related within the second degree of affinity or consanguinity to the person or ownership entity who owns the horse For the purpose of determining whether an ownership entity is excluded from claiming a horse or having a horse claimed, a family member within the second degree of affinity or consanguinity shall be defined as a parent, child, grandparent, grandchild, sibling, or in-law who owns or controls 5 percent or more of said entity.
- 2. Number of claims.
 - a. An ownership entity (sole owner, partnership, limited liability partnership, racing stable, corporation, limited liability corporation, or owner / trainer acting as an owner) shall not claim more than one horse in a race. Any commonality of ownership prohibits more than one claim in a race by any of those entities.
 - b. An authorized agent or trainer acting on behalf of an ownership entity shall not submit more than two claims in a race with two separate ownership interests.
 - c. A trainer shall not receive more than two horses from any claiming race.
- 3. Procedure for claiming. To make a claim for a horse, an eligible person shall:
 - Deposit to the person's account with the horsemen's bookkeeper, the full claiming price and applicable taxes as established by the racing secretary's conditions.
 - b. File in a locked claim box maintained for that purpose by the stewards, the claim filled out completely in writing and with sufficient accuracy to identify the claim on forms provided by the facility at least ten (10) minutes before the scheduled post time of the race.
 - c. After a claim has been filed in the claim box, it shall not be withdrawn.
 - d. If more than one claim is filed on a horse, the successful claim shall be determined by lot conducted by the Stewards or their representatives.
- 4. Eligibility price. A horse claimed may not start in a race in which the claiming price is less than the amount for which it was claimed. After 30 days, a horse may start for any claiming price. This provision shall not apply to starter handicaps in which the weight to be carried is assigned by the handicapper or for starter allowances. No right, title, or interest for any claimed horse shall be sold or transferred except in a claiming race for a period of 30 days following the date of claiming. The day claimed shall not count, but the following calendar day shall be the first day.
- Racing elsewhere. A horse that was claimed under these rules may not participate at a race meeting other than that at which it was claimed until the end of the meeting, except with written permission of the stewards. This limitation shall not apply to stakes races.
- Deposits made by cash, cashier's check or bank draft for claims must be on deposit with the Horsemen's Bookkeeper one (1) hour prior to post time of the claiming race.
- Deposits for claiming races made by wire transfer must be on deposit with the Horsemen's Bookkeeper no later than ten (10) minutes prior to post time or the end of the banking, day, whichever comes first. <u>There is a \$14 wire processing charge for this.</u>
- 8. Tax on a horse being claimed is 7%.
- 9. All claimed horses will be exchanged in the Test Barn.

CLAIMING

- 10. Transfer after claim. No claimed horse shall be delivered by the original owner to the successful claimant until the claim is approved by the stewards. Only a horse, which is officially a starter in the race, may be claimed. A subsequent disqualification of the horse by order of the stewards shall have no effect upon the claim. The stewards shall void the claim and return the horse to the original owner if:
 - a. The claimed horse suffers a fatality during the running of the race, dies, or is euthanized before leaving the track.
 - b. The commission veterinarian, during the vet's observation of the horse coming off the track or upon its arrival to the test barn, determines the horse will be placed on the vet's list as lame. The stewards shall not void the claim if, prior to the race in which the horse is claimed, the claimant elects to claim the horse regardless of whether the commission vet determines the horse will be placed on the vet's list as lame. An election made under this rule shall be entered on the claim form.
 - c. The race is called off, canceled, or declared no contest.
- 11. Other-jurisdiction rules. The commission will recognize and be governed by the rules of any other jurisdiction regulating title and claiming races when ownership of a horse is transferred or affected by a claiming race conducted in that other jurisdiction.
- 12. Determination of sex and age. The claimant, within 48 hours, shall be responsible for determining the age and sex of the horse claimed notwithstanding any designation of sex and age appearing in the program or in any racing publication. Horses that are spayed or gelded shall be properly identified as such in the program. If the claimant finds that a mare is in fact spayed or that the status of a male horse is inaccurate as stated by the program, the claimant may return the horse for full refund of the claiming price.
- 13. Affidavit by claimant. The stewards may, if they determine it necessary, require any claimant to execute a sworn statement that the claimant is claiming the horse for the claimant's own account or as an authorized agent for a principal and not for any other person.
- 14. Delivery required. No person shall refuse to deliver a properly claimed horse to the successful claimant. The claimed horse shall be disqualified from entering any race until delivery is made to the claimant.
- 15. Obstructing the rules of claiming. No person or licensee shall obstruct or interfere with another person or licensee in claiming any horse, enter into any agreement with another to subvert or defeat the object and procedures of a claiming race, or attempt to prevent any horse entered from being claimed.
- 16. Disallowance of claim. The stewards may cancel and disallow any claim within 24 hours after a race if they determine that a claim was made upon the basis of a lease, sale, or entry of a horse made for the purpose of fraudulently obtaining the privilege of making a claim; or if an eligible claimant improperly obtains information or access to horses by being present in the paddock during the claiming race unless the claimant has a horse in that claiming race, as determined solely by the stewards. In the event of a disallowance, the stewards may further order the return of a horse to its original owner and the return of all claim monies. To disallow a claim, it must be shown by clear and convincing evidence that there is a direct and substantial connection between the eligible claimant improperly gained information about the horse to be claimed, which was otherwise unavailable to other licensed owners or ownership entities. The mere appearance of impropriety is not a basis for disallowing a claim.
- 17. Protest of claim. A protest to any claim must be filed with the stewards before noon of the day following the date of the race in which the horse was claimed. Nonracing days are excluded from this rule. Should the stewards void a claim for reasons other than failure to follow the procedure for claiming, when there are multiple claims on a singular horse, said claim shall not be voided until after the determination by lot.

THOROUGHBRED PURSE DISTRIBUTION

The base purse will be reduced by \$300 each for 6th through Last Place finishers with the remaining purse to be distributed as follows:

1st	60%
2 ND	20%
3 RD	12%
4 [™]	5%
5™	3%

Note: The \$300 Purse Participation Incentive does NOT pertain to Stakes Races.

THOROUGHBRED PURSE PARTICIPATION INCENTIVE

For all overnight races (stakes not included), horses that finish 6th through Last Place will receive \$300 each for participating in that race. For Stakes Races, please refer to the stakes conditions for that particular race on how the purse monies are distributed to all runners.

HORSEMEN'S BOOKKEEPER

 The Horsemen's Bookkeeper has an office located in the southeast corner downstairs in the main grandstand building with an entrance door from the apron just north of the paddock walking ring. Business hours will be posted in the Horsemen's Bookkeeper and Racing Office's prior to the start of the meet.

All business will be conducted during the posted hours.

- Internal Revenue Service (IRS) regulations require submission of signed W-9 forms, (with Federal ID or Social Security number) to be on file with the Horsemen's Bookkeeper for every owner or managing partner of an entity before any transactions can take place (e.g. checks to be issued). Failure to file these forms will delay the process of receiving purse monies.
- Per IRGC requirements, a Deduction Authorization is required. This must be completed and on file with the Horsemen's Bookkeeper. This form allows photos, videos, fines, etc. to be deducted from your account.
- An lowa State Income Tax of 5% is withheld on purse earnings won by out-of-state horsemen.
- If you have a name or address change, please contact the Horsemen's Bookkeeper to avoid any delays in transactions, mailings, etc.
- All Entry and Starting Fees must be in the Horsemen's Bookkeeper office before that race. If a horse places 6th thru last place in Overnight races, a Purse Participation will be paid, which will cover the Jockey Mount and Lasix Fees. The Purse Participation amount for Thoroughbreds is \$300 and for Quarter Horses is \$150.
- There is a \$14 wire processing charge for all incoming wires received into the Horsemen's Bookkeeper's office.
- Checks drawn on horsemen's accounts can only be issued to account name(s), managing
 partner, authorized agent, trainer, IRGC, or Prairie Meadows. No checks will be issued to
 pay for personal expenses.
- Purse money is available upon request within two race days of the conclusion of the race day for all horses that were not selected for postrace drug testing. For horses that were selected for postrace drug testing, the Horsemen's Bookkeeper shall disburse the purse of such horses for all races, upon request, within two race days of receipt of notification that all tests with respect to such horses have cleared the drug testing laboratory (commission chemist) as reported by the Stewards. Minimum jockey mount fees may be disbursed prior to notification that the tests have cleared the testing laboratory. All accounts will automatically be closed at the end of meet. No request is necessary.
- The Horsemen's Bookkeeper will not give tax or financial advice to recipients of purse monies, etc. All recipients of purse monies, etc. are responsible to keep records of their own earnings.

CITIZENS FOR PRESERVATION OF RACING

The Citizens for Preservation of Racing fund enables the racing industry to inform, support, and encourage the Iowa Legislature as it prepares legislative action. We were successful in 2011 with Account Deposit Wagering language and are preparing for future issues that are critical to our racing industry. The CPR is funded by a voluntary \$8.00 fee, which will automatically be deducted each time your horse starts a race. If you do not wish to contribute to this committee, or are a corporation, please notify the Horsemen's Bookkeeper. Anyone is welcome to review the fund's records upon request.

THOROUGHBRED PLACEMENT / REHABILITATION

The 501(c)(3) organization HART (Hope After Racing Thoroughbreds) enables the racing industry to provide placement, aid, and rehabilitation to race horses that have finished their careers here at Prairie Meadows. HART is supported by a voluntary \$10.00 fee, which will automatically be deducted each time your horse starts in a race. If you wish to learn more about HART please contact the IA HBPA office or ITBOA office. If you do not wish to contribute, please notify the Horsemen's Bookkeeper.

WORKMENS COMPENSATION

Under lowa Workers' Compensation law, every employer is required to either furnish workers' compensation insurance on his or her employees or qualify as self-insured. Regardless of whether or not an employer carries this insurance, an employer is still responsible for payment of any benefits that may be due and owing under lowa Workers' compensation law.

BAN ON HORSE SLAUGHTER

Any Owner or Trainer based at Prairie Meadows who sells a horse for slaughter that was previously stabled at Prairie Meadows will have his/her stalls revoked.

STABLE AREA / BARNS / TACK ROOMS / FEED ROOMS

I.R.G.C. Staff, Security Personnel and/or Law Enforcement will conduct inspection of the stable area, barns, tack rooms and feed rooms in order to ensure compliance with all applicable laws, rules and regulations, the violations of which may result in the loss of privileges and/or other disciplinary action. These areas may be inspected at any time without prior notice. Illegal items, substances, or related paraphernalia will be confiscated and seized, and will not be

returned. Prohibited items may also be confiscated, but will be returned upon request at the time of departure.

<u>Bedding</u>: Straw and shavings are allowed. For ship-ins there will be shavings unless other arrangements are made with the Stall Superintendent.

Manure and Garbage Receptacles: Please put manure in the manure receptacle and the garbage in the garbage receptacle.

<u>Water Restrictions</u>: Water consumption will be monitored. All faucets must be turned off when not in use. Automatic shut-off nozzles must be used on all hoses.

Smoking: No Smoking in Barns! Any violators will be subject to a fine. Remember, NO SMOKING IN BARNS!!!

DORMITORY ROOMS / DORM DEPOSIT

- Dorm rooms shall be assigned only to trainers stabled at Prairie Meadows and will be based on the <u>number of horses stabled on grounds</u>, not the number of stalls assigned. Dorm rooms will be assigned with the intention of having "double occupancy" in each room with exception for extenuating circumstances only.
- 2. Occupants of dorm rooms must be licensed with I.R.G.C. and employed by a trainer.
- 3. It shall be the responsibility of the trainer to maintain the cleanliness and condition of each room.
- 4. A \$300 deposit shall be required per dorm room.
 - This deposit may be refunded after the room has been inspected for its condition and cleanliness.
 - b. Part or all of the deposit may be forfeited if the room is not left in satisfactory condition.
- All dorm rooms are property of Prairie Meadows Racetrack & Casino Inc. and shall be made available for inspection by Prairie Meadows Racetrack and Casino Security personnel at any time without prior notice.
- 6. Any rooms not found in satisfactory condition at any time shall be grounds for loss of dorm room privileges.
- 7. The use of dorm rooms is a privilege and may be revoked at any time with or without cause.
- If employees arrive on grounds before the trainer, it is the trainers' responsibility to make sure payment for deposit on a dorm room is made by either sending payment with the employee or making payment ahead of time.
- 9. Contact either the Security Office at 515-967-1212 or Stall Superintendent at 515-967-1209 with questions regarding dorm rooms.

VACATING & CLEANING STALLS / TACK & FEED ROOMS

Trainers are responsible for making sure the stalls, any tack or feed rooms allocated to them for the meet and bulk shaving piles are cleaned up by removing all bedding material, garbage, equipment or supplies upon vacating the barn area for the season. Failure to do so may result in loss of stall privileges in the future and cleaning fees of <u>\$100 per stall / tack-feed room</u> and <u>\$500 for bulk shaving piles</u>.

- 1. Stalls should be stripped, raked and free of bedding material.
- 2. All bedding material from stalls must go in the manure bins.
- 3. DO NOT LEAVE BEDDING IN THE SHEDROWS!
- 4. All Feed Rooms cleaned out and raked.
- 5. Feed Room pallets can be stacked against the wall and any extra pallets placed in front of the barn so they can be disposed of.
- 6. Remove <u>ALL ITEMS & TRASH</u> from Tack Rooms. There are trash bins at both ends (North & South) of the barn.
- 7. If you used Bulk Shavings and it was stored outside the barn, in a feed room or in the shed row, this area must be cleaned up or you risk losing the privilege of bulk shavings storage.
- If you hire someone to do any of these requirements, it is <u>YOUR</u> responsibility to make sure it is done in a timely and proper manner.

LICENSE REQUIREMENTS FOR 2025 LIVE RACING

The Licensing Guidelines will apply and are posted outside of the IRGC Licensing Office and the Stewards Office.

The Stable Gate and Racing Office will receive updated Licensing Hours throughout the racing season.

- All Jockeys, Owners, and Trainers / Assistant Trainers must be licensed by the post time of the first race.
- 2. lowa requires anyone that is 14 years of age or older to be fingerprinted. The date must be 2020 or newer. If you cannot provide proof that you were fingerprinted in 2020 or more recently in another racing jurisdiction, you will need to be fingerprinted in lowa. (\$42.00 fee) To provide proof of fingerprints from another racing jurisdiction you must submit a legible copy of a current license showing the fingerprint date or a letter from the racing jurisdiction which shows the date you were fingerprinted there. If you cannot provide proof you will be fingerprinted.
- All fees are to be paid by check, money order or exact change. The Commission does not accept credit cards, nor will the Commission provide change.
- 4. All applicants must answer all questions on the application. If you had no new "Yes" answers pertaining to rulings since last being licensed at Prairie Meadows, you may write the following: "no new rulings since last being licensed at Prairie Meadows' and please put the last year you were licensed. You must still mark the appropriate "Yes" box. If you have "Yes" answers pertaining to your criminal history you must be specific with your answers. You have to list any criminal history each time you are to be licensed. The Commission does not allow the following: "See record", "On file", etc.
- 5. All owners must disclose their percent of ownership, the horse's name, and if applicable, all other Owners and their percentage on the back of the application. If the horse(s) are leased, add capital "L" beside the name of the horse(s) and list the Lessor in the Other Owners column.
- 6. Both the Lessor and Lessee must be licensed as Owners.
- All Owners must list who their Trainer will be and the horse(s) that will be racing in Iowa (Question 20. B on application).
- If you are going to be licensed as an Owner/Trainer you cannot name another Trainer. You
 must train your own horses.
- All applicants must sign and date their application on the back or licensing cannot be completed.
- 10. Some positions require authorized signatures on the license application. If you have any questions regarding your application, please call the IRGC Licensing Office.

LICENSE REQUIREMENTS FOR 2025 LIVE RACING

- 11. Partnerships/Corporations/Stable Names: All parties owning 5% or more must be licensed as individual Owners and a Partnership/Corporation/Stable Name form must be completed. The person executing the application needs to list all parties involved with the following information: Name, percentage of ownership, complete address, date of birth, and social security number. Be sure the person executing the application signs and dates page 3 of the application or licensing cannot be completed.
- 12. To be licensed, all applicants must show two forms of identification. At least one form of identification must show a photo and one form of identification must show your social security number or FIN. All non-citizens (except owners) must supply the licensing office with a current I-94 or Green Card and social security card (or FIN) documenting authorization to work in the United States at the time of licensing. If you do not have the required information, you will not be licensed. Non-English-speaking applicants must be accompanied by an interpreter to be processed.
- 13. Incomplete applications will be returned and this may delay your licensing.

NOTICE OF DRONE OPERATING DURING THE MEET

Pursuant to FAA regulations, Prairie Meadows is notifying all employees, racing officials, breed organization representatives and all owners / trainers / riders / stable area workers etc. that a drone will be operating during our Racing Meet. The drone will operate over airspace that is restricted from the public, but will at times fly over or "transition" those working in restricted areas that require IRGC Badges or Security escorts.



IOWA BRED THOROUGHBRED PROGRAM

Prairie Meadows is proud of the Iowa Bred incentives available to all Iowa Bred owners who race with us. The breeding rules of Iowa include provisions for both purse supplements and breeder awards, and they are available for every race. This year the supplement program for the Thoroughbreds will be 32% for restricted races, and 40% for open company races. (Subject to adjustment) An example of the impact the supplement has on the purse is offered below. <u>Note:</u> The example shown below does <u>NOT</u> take into consideration paying all places in races with more than five (5) runners. SAFETY EQUIPMENT (HELMET / VEST / WHIP-CROP)

Per IRGC rule 10.2(9) Helmets and vests: Any person on horseback on facility grounds shall wear a protective helmet and safety vest.

a. A jockey participating in a race shall have a helmet that is not altered and complies with one of the following standards or later revisions:

- (1). American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM 1163).
- (2). European standards (EN-1384 or PAS-015 or VG1).
- (3). Australian / New Zealand standards (AS / NZ 3838).
- (4). ARB HS 2012
- (5). Snell Equestrian standard 2001.

b. A jockey participating in a race shall have a vest that is not altered and complies with one of the following minimum safety standards or later revisions:

- (1). British Equestrian Trade Association (BETA) 2000 Level 1.
- (2). Euro Norm (EN) 13158: 2000 Level 1
- (3). American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) F1781-08 or F1937.
- (4). Shoe and Allied Trade Research Association (SATRA) Jockey Vest Document M6 Issue 3.
- (5). Australian Racing Board (ARB) Standard 1.1998.

Unless permitted by the Stewards, no whip or substitute for a whip shall exceed one pound or 30 inches and no bridle shall exceed two pounds. Jockeys may not use a whip on a two-year-old horse before April 1 of each year, nor shall a jockey or other person engage in excessive or indiscriminate whipping of any horse at any time.

For jockey's, a safety vest shall be mandatory, shall weigh no more than two pounds, and shall be designed to provide shock-absorbing protection to the upper body.

BARN AREA ELECTRICITY GUIDELINES

- All fans must be a 3-prong grounded cord. No exceptions.
- Make sure all extension cords are in good condition and that they are no smaller than 12 GAUGE.
- All cords must have a GROUND prong, no splitters are to be used unless the splitter is molded into the extension cord, no aftermarket splitters allowed.
- Fans used in the barn areas must be FACTORY SEALED and have a factory cord installed. Fans must be rated for wet / dry area and MUST HAVE a GROUND prong
- Report all electrical issues IMMEDIATELY to Facilities Dispatch 515-967-8500.

NOTICE OF DRONE OPERATING DURING THE MEET

2025 Iowa Quarter Horse Hair Testing Protocol

Commission Hair Testing

- Commission will conduct hair testing on all Stakes races. Additional hair testing during the racing season at Prairie Meadows will be at the discretion of IRGC and the State Vet's Office. Any horse on PMR&C grounds is subject to hair testing at any time.
 - Stabling of Quarter Horse Finalists. If a horse is a finalist for a stake race that had nomination, sustaining and/or late supplemental payments in order to be eligible to participate and qualified through time trials, the horse shall remain on facility premises until the running of the final. If a horse becomes a finalist for a stake race that does not run qualifying time trials due to not having enough entrants to run trials, that horse most be stabled on facility premises by the date time trials were scheduled and remain on facility premises until the trunsing of the final. A horse removed from facility premises or is not stabled on facility premises by the date time trials were scheduled, will not be allowed to enter for the final or will be scratched from the final and will not be eligible for a refund of the fees paid or earn any purse monies from the final.
 - Commission will collect hair samples from the 10 fastest qualifiers plus 2 "Also Eligible" horses (the 11th and 12th fastest
 timed horses) on all stakes that had nomination, sustaining and/or late supplemental payments in order to be eligible to
 participate. If no trials are necessary and the race to be run as a "Final Only", the horses that entered for trials and remain
 eligible for the Final, will have hair samples collected for testing prior to entering for the final of that stake race. Per
 agreement with AQHA Racing Challenge, up to 3" Also Eligible" horses will have hair samples taken from qualifying trials.
 - Commission will collect hair samples from all 1st, 2nd and 3rd place finishers in stakes races that did not require a nomination, sustaining and/or late supplemental payment in order to be eligible to participate.
 - Commission could collect hair samples on a random basis from horses during racing or out-of-competition.
- 2) Commission will perform the testing under the following terms and guidelines:
 - Commission reserves the right to test any horse on PMR&C grounds at any time. Failure to make a horse available for hair testing as requested by State Vet will result in the horse being placed on the Vet's List and ineligible to enter any races at PMR&C until a negative hair test is received under terms and conditions required by the State Vet.
 - Trial Races: Each qualifying horse will report to the test barn or trainer/owner will otherwise make horse available on a date
 and at a time/schedule specified by the State Vet. Failure to report to the test barn or as otherwise scheduled will result in
 horse automatically being placed on the Vet's List and ineligible for the stakes final as well as a loss of the purse from the
 qualifying race. Horse will remain on Vet's List until a negative hair test is received under terms and conditions required by
 State Vet. If no trials are necessary (race to be run as a "Final Only") all horses entered for trials will be hair tested under
 the terms and guidelines explained here.
 - Owner/trainer is responsible for any/all costs associated with subsequent hair testing to remove horse from Vet's List.
 - The hair sample will be collected in a manner prescribed by the State Vet and state lab with normal chain of custody
 protocol (i.e. trainer witnesses sample collection/labeling etc.).
 - NO split samples will be collected.
 - The hair sample will be sent to the state lab for processing.
 - The determination of the state lab regarding the results of hair testing is <u>FINAL</u>. Horses with a positive hair test waive the right to appeal this determination or seek a stay to allow a horse to continue to compete absent a negative hair test.
 - Hair testing will focus on any long acting compounds that have muscle-building effects and that are prohibited from being
 present at any level (i.e. zero-tolerance drugs). Common drugs being tested include (but are NOT limited to):
 Clenbuterol, Ractopamine, Zilpaterol, Albuterol, Bambuterol, Pirbuterol, Anabolic steroids, boldenone esters,
 testosterone esters, and nandrolone esters, stanozol.
 - A horse that qualified in a trial race for a stake final and subsequently has a positive hair test as a part of the stakes race testing will lose its purse from the qualifying trial race. A horse that ran in a stake race without qualifying trials and subsequently has a positive hair test as a part of the stakes race testing will lose its purse and the stakes purse monies will be reallocated based on the number of starters after ineligible/disqualified horses in accordance with the stakes race purse distribution percentages.
- IQHRA will provide a resolution or some other type of written documentation that establishes that the association supports this hair testing and the terms and protocol as outlined.

MEDICATION INFORMATION

NOTE: All HISA Covered Horses (Thoroughbreds) Will Follow HISA & HIWU Regulations for Medications and Administration Times. All Quarter Horses Will Follow Guidelines Shown Below.

Iowa does not have any written rules or regulations on thresholds (other than indicated below) or withdrawal times. The State Veterinarians will not give advice on withdrawal times or information on testing levels other than listed below. We would suggest you discuss with your practicing veterinarian or refer to the RCI Schedule of Controlled Therapeutic Substances which can be found on the RCI website for guidance. http://arcicom.businesscatalyst.com/assets/arci-controlled-therapeutic-medication-schedule---version-1.0.pff. A non-practicing veterinary group in accordance with IRGC rules and regulations administers Salix in Iowa.

NON-STEROIDAL ANTI-INFLAMMATORY DRUGS (NSAIDs).

(1) The use of one of three approved NSAIDs shall be permitted under the following conditions:

 The level does not exceed the following permitted serum or plasma threshold concentrations which are consistent with administration by a single intravenous injection at least 24 hours before the post time for the race in which the horse is entered:

Phenylbutazone (or its metabolite oxyphenylbutazone) – 2 micrograms per milliliter;

- Flunixin 20 nanograms per milliliter;
- Ketoprofen 2 nanograms per milliliter.

The NSAIDs listed in numbered paragraph "1" or any other NSAIDs are prohibited from being administered within the 24 hours before
post time for the race in which the horse is entered.

3. The presence of more than one of the three approved NSAIDs, with the exception of phenylbutazone in a concentration below 1 microgram per milliliter of serum or plasma, or the presence of any unapproved NSAID in the post-race serum or plasma sample is not permitted. The use of all but one of the approved NSAIDs shall be discontinued at least 48 hours before the post time for the race in which the horse is entered.

(2) Any horse to which an NSAID has been administered shall be subject to having a blood sample(s), urine sample(s) or both taken at the direction of the official veterinarian to determine the quantitative NSAID level(s) or the presence of other drugs which may be present in the blood or urine sample(s).

PERMISSIBLE RACE DAY APPLICATIONS

Magnetic Blankets; Thermal Blankets; Muds/Poultices; Electrolyte powders or pastes (Approved by Vet's Office); Epsom Salts; Rubbing Alcohol; Bigeloil; Cold Water Bandages, Turbulators; Commercial Hoof Dressing (No Foot Freeze/No Homemade Recipes); and Cold Laser.

NERVING, BLOCKING, FREEZING AND MISC.

A horse is ineligible to start a race when: it has been nerved by surgical neurectomy at any level or location in the leg or it has been blocked with alcohol or injected with any other foreign substance or drug to desensitize the nerves of the leg.

It is a felony in this state to race a horse on which a surgical or other procedure has been performed (at any time) in which the nerves of the horse have been severed, destroyed or removed.

BISPHOSPHONATES, JOINT INJECTION, THYROXINE / THYROID MODULATORS-HORMONES

A horse is ineligible to enter a race when:

1) A horse, under four years of age, has been injected with bisphosphonates. Horses four years of age or older may only be administered bisphosphonate if the bisphosphonate is FDA approved for use in the horse and administered in accordance with the label requirements and only for diagnosed cases of navicular disease. If bisphosphonate is administered as permitted by rule, the commission shall be notified within 24 hours of the administration. If bisphosphonate is detected in sampling or if a horse is administered bisphosphonate, the horse shall be placed on the veterinarian's list for no less than six months.

2) A horse has had any intra-articular joint injection within the past six days. This includes any joint injection not just corticosteroids. For the purpose of counting number of days a horse is incligible to trun following an intra-articular injection, injection is the first day. The detection of two or more corticosteroids constitutes a stacking violation.

3) A horse has been administered thyroxine and thyroid modulators/hormones including, but not limited to, those containing T4 (tetraiodothyronine/thyroxine), T3 (triiodothyronine), or combinations thereof. This excludes a horse that has been individually prescribed thyroxine and thyroid modulators/hormones. Trainers are required to turn in a copy of the prescription for each horse they are currently treating.
